

Job Title: National Security Intelligence Analyst Location: Washington, DC Position Type: Full-Time

Position Summary

Provide analytical support to the Department of Energy's {"DOE'S") National Nuclear Security Administration ("NNSA") Office of Counterterrorism and Counterproliferation. This position is contingent upon contract award and/or task-based approvals.

Essential Functions

The primary purpose of this position is to provide analytical support for DOE/NNSA counterterrorism activities. This position provides technical support as follows:

- Provide expertise on technical activities required to advise and enable all aspects of nuclear counterproliferation and nuclear counterterrorism missions.
- Develop policy and strategic-level documents for the NNSA Office of Nuclear Threat Science to assist in analyzing nuclear threat devices, foreign weapons of a proliferant concern, and any device that may have fallen outside of a foreign state's custody.
- Coordinate policy decisions with interagency partners, including the White House National Security Council ("NSC"), DOE, Department of Defense, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Department of Homeland Security, Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and the broader intelligence community.
- Coordinate international outreach to stakeholders on nuclear counterterrorism.
- Develop documents, reports, and briefings in support of DOE/NNSA, NSC, and congressional stakeholders.
- Support the management of interagency and international technical collaborations.
- Represent the NNSA at technical, interagency, and international meetings.
- Draft and provide guidance on policies and procedures to ensure the protection of sensitive classified information.

Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in security, public policy, management, or a related field.
- 8 or more years in intelligence counterterrorism activities.
- DOE Q or DOD TS security clearance.
- Experience with DOE/NNSA-related offices and other governmental intelligence stakeholders in the field of nuclear science — including detection, smuggling and forensics.
- Working familiarity with DOE/DOD intelligence assessments.
- Persuasive written and verbal communication skills.





Preferred Qualifications

- Working knowledge of technical and policy concepts related to nuclear weapons, counterintelligence, counterterrorism, and counterproliferation.
- Experience navigating interagency relationships, e.g., DOD, NNSA, etc.
