

Job Title: Senior Policy Analyst

Position Summary

The Senior Policy Analyst provides technical policy expertise to support and manage multiple projects and initiatives within the National Nuclear Security Administration's ("NNSA's") Office of Counterterrorism and Counterproliferation. The position is contingent upon contract award and/or task-based approvals.

Essential Functions

The primary purpose of this position is to provide expertise and technical support for Department of Energy ("DOE")/NNSA counterterrorism activities. The Senior Policy Analyst provides technical support as follows:

- Support the international and interagency policy division for nuclear-related counterterrorism exchanges by coordinating, researching, developing, and preparing policy on issues of importance to U.S. interagency partners and the White House's National Security Staff.
- Provide expertise on the nexus between counterterrorism, counterproliferation and incident response policy formulation to DOE, NNSA and other relevant interagency offices
- Draft white papers to advance innovative approaches to nuclear counterterrorism and nuclear security.
- Prepare and support National Security Staff on matters related to its interagency policy committees.
- Draft materials for Secretary and Administrator-level DOE/NNSA reports on matters of interest and importance.
- Serve as liaison to NNSA's office of public affairs and congressional affairs.
- Maintain expertise on nuclear counterterrorism, counterproliferation and incident response missions to leverage the DOE's and NNSA's broad-based science, technology, and engineering capabilities and build upon the foundation of the departments' nuclear weapons program and other national security responsibilities.







Minimum Qualifications

- Master's degree in national security studies, public policy or related field.
- 15 or more years of technical experience with nuclear counterterrorism or another equivalent security field.
- Excellent written and verbal communication and organizational skills.
- Demonstrated knowledge and experience related to nuclear counterterrorism, counterproliferation and incident response policy formulation.
- Experience working and collaborating with government agencies and stakeholder groups on nuclear weapons and/or national security issues.
- Experience leading multiple stakeholders with diverse interests, finding ways to encourage people to share knowledge and leverage strengths, and using sophisticated collaboration, communication and coordination techniques.
