**June 15, 2015****TechSource, Inc. Awarded Security Support Services Contract for Department of Energy's Nevada Field Office**

*Los Alamos, NM.* TechSource, Inc. is pleased to announce it has been awarded a Security Support Services contract for Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration, Nevada Field Office of the Assistant Manager for Safety and Security (NNSA/NFO/AMSS).

NNSA/NFO/AMSS provides security oversight for all facilities and operations in support of all missions under NNSA/NFO purview. NNSA/NFO operates the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS) located approximately 65 miles northwest of Las Vegas, Nevada. NNSS covers approximately 1,360 square miles (slightly larger than the state of Rhode Island) where the DOE, NNSA, and other U.S. Government agencies conduct various missions that include classified and unclassified experiments, training, exercises, activities, and programs. The main mission areas for NNSA/NFO are: Stockpile Stewardship, Nuclear Nonproliferation and Counter Terrorism, National Emergency Response, Radioactive Waste Management, and Work for Others.

In addition NNSA/NFO provides oversight over numerous government owned contractor operated facilities in Nevada. These include the NNSS, the NNSA/NFO main office located at the Nevada Support Facility in North Las Vegas, Nevada, and the Remote Sensing Laboratory at Nellis Air Force Base in Las Vegas, Nevada. NNSA/NFO also has oversight of contractor facilities in Livermore and Santa Barbara, California; Los Alamos, New Mexico; and Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland.

Under this contract TechSource and its partner, Pro2Serve (the current incumbent), will provide security support services including: Vulnerability assessments; Information classification; Personnel security; Badge office operations (Access Control, Pass & Badging, Visitor Control, and Personnel Security); Clearance processing; Operations security (OPSEC); Security awareness; Classified matter protection and control (CMPC); Safeguards and Security Information Management System Support; M&O Security Webpage; and Safeguards and Security Professional Training Program Support.

Don Trost, TechSource Executive Vice President and the Director of Washington D.C. Operations, shared his confidence in the team's ability to leverage its extensive expertise, "We, along with our partner Pro2Serve, are certain in our ability to provide a comprehensive and robust suite of security solutions. The lessons we have garnered, from decades of hands-on security work both at DOE Headquarters and in the field, will ensure NNSA/NFO/AMSS achieves its mission critical activities in the most timely and cost-effective manner. This is the 16th award for the Team E-TESA, led by TechSource, under this NNSA BPA. The award is valued at \$12,383,204.63. To date, Team E-TESA has been awarded a total BPA contract value of \$ 70,869,130.
