Los Alamos, NM. Dr. Everet Beckner, a distinguished figure in nuclear security, and former Deputy Administrator of the Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE NNSA) and two-decade TechSource Board Member, passed away on November 22, 2024.

"Dr. Everet Beckner's passing is a monumental loss to the world of nuclear security and to all of us who had the privilege of knowing him personally. He leaves a legacy of steadfast commitment to safeguarding our nation. We will carry forward his legacy with the same dedication and passion that he exemplified throughout his life," shared Brian D'Andrea, Chairman and CEO of TechSource.

Dr. Beckner's remarkable career spanned multiple high-level roles, including Vice President at Lockheed Martin Corporation and Deputy Chief Executive at the Atomic Weapons Establishment in Aldermaston, UK. He also served as the DOE's Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Defense Programs and held various senior leadership positions at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque. Most recently Dr. Beckner had been serving as a member of the TechSource Board of Directors and as an advisor to the STRATCOM, Strategic Advisory Group.

Dr. Beckner's unparalleled expertise in nuclear weapons production, design labs, and facilities was crucial in shaping the Cold War era nuclear weapons complex to present day Nuclear Security Enterprise (NSE). His deep understanding of DOE and NNSA projects has been instrumental in advancing vital initiatives. Since his retirement from NNSA, Dr. Beckner continued advising NNSA, DoD, and industry, sharing his knowledge and experience, thus, leaving an indelible mark on our ability to advance the nation's strategic deterrent mission.

"The nation has lost more than a brilliant mind; it has lost a true patriot. His legacy transcends his achievements, the lives he touched and the national policies he shaped. As we mourn his loss, we take solace in his lasting impact, remembering him as a luminary and guiding light for the future of the NSE," commented Jeff Giangliuli, President and COO of TechSource, Inc.

Dr. Beckner earned his B.S. in Physics from Baylor University in 1956, and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Physics from Rice University in 1959 and 1961, respectively.
